

Debriefing sheet – Key to Soil

Note from author: this checklist should help to not forget any points during the debriefing. If some points were not made tangible through the actual game experience, you can explain how they can be illustrated in other game sessions and give real-life examples.

" - " = Barriers ; " + " = Levers

- Barriers to access to agro-supplies (upstream)
 - Lack of access to agroecological inputs
 - + Purchasing groups
 - + E-commerce
 - Lack of access to equipment
 - + CUMA cooperative

- Downstream barriers
 - High volume on sensitive species, low volume on alternative species
 - Unsatisfactory quality of resistant varieties
 - Low price → Low investment capacity
 - + Joint planning
 - + Raising consumer awareness → diversification / access to good quality

- Barriers to the agri-food system (diversification)
 - Small farm size reinforces the following constraints: little income, little investment capital and little ability to generate sufficient levels of production.
 - Large size → the contrary + ability to test on small area.
 - + Farmer cooperative

- Barriers to accessing new know-how: lack of technical references
 - + New knowledge production

- Cognitive barriers at farm and agri-food system level: values and mental representations of stakeholders
 - Lack of cooperation
 - + Confidence-building organization

- Cognitive barriers at farm level
 - Fixing effect
 - + Demonstration of economic superiority
 - + Training to think at the cropping system/food system level

 - Lack of time
 - + Workforce cooperative mutualizing employees
